


## Career Mode Bargain Players and Best Buys




If you buy a 17 or 18 year old that has good potential, you can pick them up cheaply, and grow them over a period of several years.

Try to get the players with the best potential, and aim to retain them. Remember that sometimes a player won't be interested in changing teams - players that have just signed to a new club tend to want to stay there.

If you can't get a player that you have your eye on, look for others that have high potential and that are available for transfer.
